



Paid Legal Advocate Internship - 2024

The Resource Center is seeking Interns to support the Legal team. This internship aims to build our People's Power and skills to advocate fiercely for themselves and the community through sharing our people's historical and current radical narrative.

Interns will support the legal clinic by assisting in the gathering and processing of all current legal services such as marijuana expungements, fingerprint clearance, etc. Interns will have the opportunity to gain experience and education in the legal processes as well as assist in developing and coordinating community events/clinics and presentations during their internship term.

Responsibilities Include:

- Conduct intakes with clients and offer appropriate legal services
- Conduct legal research for individuals as needed
- Complete and file petitions
- Attend meetings
- Provide support to ongoing projects, including, but not limited to, our Legal Clinic, Election Protection, and Legislation advocacy
- Other research projects and duties as assigned.

Interns will receive \$20/hr for 15 hours per week. The start date will be Monday, February 5th, 2024 until November 15th, 2024 with the possibility to extend the internship depending on needs. Work will be hybrid with weekly in-person staff meetings and occasional in-person support for programmatic and organizational events.
